2. Choose a country where you wish to be involved.
3. Contact the RMI International Office in Lehigh Acres, FL and express your desire.
4. The national Association of Churches working with RMI in your country of choice, in cooperation with RMI, will choose a church to possibly become your very own Sister Church!
5. Request a date and the Team Training Materials from RMI to prepare a Leadership Team from your church to make the initial visit to your Sister Church.
6. The RMI Cross-Cultural Bridge Team will meet all your needs during this visit to your new sister church.
7. Your team will live in the village and enjoy in-depth fellowship with new brothers and sisters in the Lord.
8. The team will also engage in ministry and whatever simple project they might desire to accomplish at this time.
9. The team will sit with the leaders of your Sister Church and together share dreams, pray and collaborate on possible future ministries and projects.
10. The Leadership Team will return to your church and report all that has transpired and a decision will be made at that time as to the future of the relationship.
